Career SEND Group One

With a career focus on what a young person CAN achieve:

Career SEND Group One – does not include those with more complex needs

- Young people who <u>typically will not</u> take GCSEs/Level 2 qualifications
- Positive career outcomes could include supported internships, inclusive apprenticeships, supported employment, volunteering, provision via the Local Offer, T Levels, Traineeships, supported Enterprise/selfemployment, FE College.
- Meaningful supported living opportunities.

Key issue:

Career opportunities availability – supply and demand

Career Development needs to:

- Start early
- Raise the aspirations of everyone involved
- Extend over a long period of time, building trust
- Include extensive support and encouragement
- Factor in time for preparation of everyone involved
- Bring families into the process early
- Enable employers to appreciate the starting points of these young people and the journey they need to travel



Careers at EVERY Level

- Starts early in school
- Raises aspirations of everyone involved
- Builds confidence with families critical for career success
- Works with and supports the Gatsby Benchmarks
- Enables rehearsing for work and reflection
- Supports employers to develop their understanding of young people
- Builds two-way confidence for employers and young people
- Provides evidence for employers if the young person is not taking recognised qualifications



Careers at EVERY Level

Aim: to enable young people with learning difficulties who are working at Entry-level and Functional skills levels to improve the possibility and probability of paid employment; develop work-related skills for independent living and to enrich life experience.

Objectives:

- Increase the possibility and probability of paid work
- Increase employability skills
- Increase the level of work-related skills for independent living
- Enrich life experience
- Work in a genuine and authentic way
