Our mission is to provide young people, underserved communities and underrepresented groups with the enterprise skills and experiences to better prepare them for successful employment or selfemployment.

Some Context



Some 45,797 young people either registered as self-employed or formed their own limited companies between 2018 and 2020¹



Young entrepreneurs (under 35) twice as likely to say their business' primary aim is to solve a social or environmental problem (39% vs 18%)⁴



Over a quarter have said they would be more likely to start their own businesses if they had business or enterprise training or education²



Young entrepreneurs (under 35) more likely to choose suppliers which do good for society, even if they cost more or they have to compromise in some other way (51% vs 36%)⁴



Over half (52%)
of young people have "never been taught about running [their]
own business."²



The total cost to the UK economy of low essential skills is estimated to be £22.2 billion⁵



What is Tycoon?



- Unique national enterprise competition for students aged 6 to 18
- It is completely free to take part, and we offer good-will loans to support students in creating and running their first business.
- Participants write a business plan, are lent money, and start a business
- They do so through the Tycoon platform
- Tycoon Talentino open to all SEND students across the UK

- •£45k lent in goodwill loans
- •1,384 students from 90 schools started their Tycoon business journey

The process

Step 1: The Lead Teacher:

• Submit a simple registration form and wait for your Tycoon account approval.

Step 2: The Tycoon platform

- Update your "Financial details" on your school dashboard.
- Complete a Finance Confirmation Form. Send it to our Tycoon Lead.

Step 3:

- Once your groups are ready, go to the "Businesses" section on your school dashboard.
- Click on "Add a new business".
- Fill in the business information.
- Select the Competition window called "Tycoon Talentino League".

Example: Charity Tree

Skills Centre Plus | Loan Amount: £289 | Profit: £430 | Website

The team from Skills Centre Plus developed the concept of selling donated items on behalf of a charity to help them maximise funds from donations. Through this they vastly improved the turnover of products, provided a bigger sales space and sold items which are normally turned away. They were able to support the Lindsay Lodge Hospice Health charity, make profit for their business and helped people who were struggling with the cost of living crisis.
